Malin Gallery is a contemporary art gallery founded in 2015. The gallery relocated in 2019 to a new 5,000 sq. ft. multi-level space in the West Chelsea neighborhood of New York adjacent to the High Line and the newly-opened arts center The Shed. Malin Gallery began to exhibit in Aspen in 2021. The summer 2022 program in Aspen will feature a solo exhibition of recent paintings



by Amy Myers entitled *A Hydromelodic Event* followed by a joint exhibition of new work by Jesse Krimes and Russell Craig.

Malin Gallery represents a diverse roster of living artists and estates. Gallery exhibitions have been favorably reviewed in multiple national publications, including *The New York Times*, *The New Yorker*, *Artforum*, *The Wall Street Journal*, *ARTnews*, *Time Out — New York*, *Galerie*, *The San Francisco Chronicle*, *The London Review of Books* and *Artnet News*.

Work by Malin Gallery artists is included in renowned public collections worldwide,

including the Museum of Modern Art — New York; the Metropolitan Museum of Art; the Whitney Museum of American Art; the Brooklyn Museum; the Solomon R. Guggenheim Museum; the San Francisco Museum of Modern Art and the New Orleans Museum of Art. Gallery artists have received important grants and awards including the Pollock-Krasner Foundation Grant, the NYFA Fellowship, the National Endowment for the Arts Award, the Robert Rauschenberg Fellowship, the Art for Justice Fund Grant and the John Simon Guggenheim Fellowship.
